Results for the sale on 22 June 2015, in Paris

Automobilia, Lot 96 : Exceptionnel Casque – Ayrton Senna prototype, dedicated, signed and dated 1990 season, sold including premium 98 500 € / 112 290 \$ (estimate : 45 000 – 65 000 €).

It was in the main hall of the Théâtre du Rond-Point des Champs-Élysées, a stone's throw from Artcurial's Headquarters, that Maître Hervé Poulain began the 8th edition of the « Automobiles sur les Champs » series of sales. To loud applause, the auction finished just after 21.30, having realised a total of 11 208 344 € / 12 777 512 \$, with 80 % of all lots sold. Artcurial established 6 new world record auction prices during the evening (complete list below).

The morning started with the Automobilia sale, that made 258 329 € / 294 495 \$ including premium, and starred the ex-Ayrton Senna prototype helmet (lot 96) that fetched 98 500 € / 112 290 \$, double its estimate!

However, it was not until 18.00 that the spectacle truly began and the 71 collectors' cars selected by Artcurial Motorcars entered the spotlight at the Théâtre du Rond-Point des Champs-Élysées, in front of a packed hall. From the beginning of the sale, the supercars found themselves centre stage. The 1991 Ferrari F40 (lot 11) sold for 1 012 200 € / 1 155 048 \$ as the audience held its breath. A few minutes later, it was the turn of the rare 1925 Bugatti Type 13 « Brescia » (lot 17) to engage the bidders, selling for 834 400 € / 951 216 \$ after a memorable bidding battle (estimate : 150 000 – 250 000 €). This barnfind motor car had been discovered in the East of France and had been in the same family ownership since 1953.

Another star of the sale, the 1966 Alpine A210 berlinetta (lot 20) found itself competing once more. This French racing car, a competitor in the Le Mans 24 Hour race in period, sold above its estimate for 476 800 € / 543 552 \$. This excellent result, a world record auction price for the model, is a great tribute to the legendary French marque that is preparing to make its return.

Other sports cars, this time German Porsches, also remained very competitive. As Maître Poulain said, « *the Porschistes have tasted victory in the Le Mans 24 Hours* ». The 1970 Porsche 911 S/T 2,3 L (lot 47) sold for 905 900 € / 1 032 726 \$, while the 1956 356 C Carrera changed hands for 596 000 € / 679 440 \$.

The Italians also shared the limelight, with two Maserati models from the 1960s. The sculptural red body of the sublime Maserati 3500 GT by Frua (lot 31) attracted much attention from collectors, causing a bidding battle that saw the hammer come down at 447 000 € / 509 580 \$. The bright yellow Maserati Ghibli 4,7 L (lot 32) was also a hit, selling above estimate for 351 600 € / 400 824 \$.

Mathieu Lamoure, Managing Director of the Collectors' cars Department at Artcurial declared : « *Artcurial Motorcars' speciality, the discovery of cars that have remained in private ownership for many years, once again attracted international collectors. These cars were snapped up ! This was also the case with one-owner cars such as the Fiat Dino (lot 5) that doubled its estimate selling for 188 300 € / 214 662 \$. More accessible 'Youngtimers' are becoming more highly sought after, like the Lancia Delta (lot 46) that made 66 800 € / 76 152 \$* ».
