On Sunday 1 November, Artcurial Motorcars ended 2015 in style with the 9th edition of the *Automobiles sur les Champs* sale. With Maitre Hervé Poulain on the rostrum in a packed saleroom, the auction totalled 7,2 M€ / 8M\$, with 80% of the lots selling, and a new world record auction price. This was preceded by the *Automobilia* sale which realised 99 300 € / 109 230 \$.

As expected, Ferrari featured strongly, with two of the trio of Berlinetta Boxers making the top ten prices (the 1978 Ferrari 512 Berlinetta Boxer (lot 143) sold for 381 400 € / 419 540 \$, and the 1983 Ferrari 512i Berlinetta Boxer (141) made 321 800 € / 353 980 \$).

Ever popular, the Aston Martins in the sale attracted high bids. The 1970 DBS Vantage (lot 122), a great classic, changed hands for 200 300 € / 220 330 \$ (including premium), while the iconic DB4 Series 4 from 1963 (lot 124), achieved 548 300 € / 603 130 \$ including premium. The Porsches continued to attract the attention of enthusiasts, including the 1993 Porsche 964 Turbo 3.6 « Exclusive » (lot 137) which sold for 302 800 € / 333 030 \$ (including premium), and the 1988 Porsche 930 Turbo (lot 166), for 271 800 € / 298 980 \$ (including premium).

The BMW Z8 (lot 139), famously driven by James Bond in the film « The World Is Not Enough » was one of the stars of the sale. On the eve of the marque's centenary, the 2000 Z8 sold for 280 700 € / 308 770 \$ (including premium), well above its estimate and establishing a world record auction price for this model.

Matthieu Lamoure, Managing Director of Artcurial Motorcars declared: « *Once again the Automobiles sur les Champs sale has been very successful, with a dynamic market for cars from the 1980s. The Astons and Porsches attracted strong bidding and continue to hold their prices. This sale has ended the year in style, with a sales total of over 71 M€ / 78 M\$ for 2015, a tenfold increase since Artcurial Motorcars was created in 2009.* »

Artcurial Motorcars has obtained the highest price for a car sold at auction during the 2014/2015 season, with the sale at *Retromobile* in February of this year of the 1961 Ferrari 250GT SWB California Spider from the famous Baillon Collection for 16,3 M€ / 18,5 M\$.

The next sale will be on 5 February 2016, at the *Retromobile Salon* in Paris. This promises to be another historic event, with the last example of the Ferrari 250 GT Berlinetta from 1963 already consigned (estimate : 9 – 12 M€ / 10 – 13,2 M\$).
